

74-045 & 74-365 Crash Wrap Weather Barrier Films Standard Operating Procedure:

REV 1.28.25

Application:

In order to ensure Crash Wrap is applied correctly, please <u>read all instructions below</u>. Inspect and clean vehicle surfaces before installing film to assure that any finishes to be covered by the film are adequately protected.

- 1. Carefully clean and dry areas where you intend to apply Crash Wrap, use VIETEK 55-550 Glassy on all surfaces, also the vehicle should be clean of any snow or frost before application. Although Crash Wrap will adhere to clean cold and/or wet surfaces, it adheres best to a clean, warm, and dry surface.
- 2. If you must install film on a wet surface, it is important to remove the film and dry the surface as soon as possible. <u>DO NOT ALLOW</u> the sun to bake through film that has water trapped between the film and paint <u>as it will cause paint damage</u> similar to the damage caused when a vehicle is baked in a paint booth with water trapped beneath the masking plastic and paint.
- 3. Use a towel to smooth the film to the vehicle surface. Sharp edges can poke through the film and cause physical harm or injury to your person.
- 4. Install Crash Wrap with slight tension and trim any excess/loose material. Loosely installed film is subject to being removed by the wind.
- 5. Test areas to be covered with Crash Wrap to assure painted substrate is sound, a failing OEM finish, poor or improper repairs can be pulled off during the removal process. Clean and dry surface, test with masking tape to assure painted surface integrity before proceeding.
- 6. If installing over a Sunroof opening: Cover opening with cardboard before installing Crash Wrap to prevent potential water build up from creating a magnifying glass effect that can damage the interior.
- 7. The adhesive is water-based and cannot be removed with solvent-based cleaners. In rare instances of adhesive transfer, use an ammonia-based glass cleaner or isopropyl alcohol to remove.

Storage:

Crash Wrap features an adhesive designed specifically for automotive aftermarket applications. Warm film will properly adhere to a cold vehicle. Film stored below 60 degrees may not. Store unused Crash Wrap at room temperature in its original carton. Store the carton in a dry area. Extended exposure to humidity will cause the adhesive to fail.
